The Holy Season

Having completed our celebrations of Our Lord's Nativity and His Baptism in the Jordan River, we now look ahead to the climax of the Church's liturgical year. Pascha- the Resurrection of Our Lord, God, and Savior Jesus Christ, will fall on April 12. We hope that, through God's mercy, we see as many people as possible join us for the upcoming divine services, which the Church offers during the Holy Season of Great Lent, Holy Week, and Pascha. This quarterly bulletin provides the service schedules for February, March, and April, including the services of Great Lent, Holy Week, Pascha, and Bright Week. In the Early Church, Great Lent served to prepare catechumens for holy baptism. Thus, those who entered the fast did so with a readiness to struggle, both against the ways of this world and against their own brokenness and unrighteousness. Moreover, they entered this season with even greater hope in both Our Lord Jesus Christ's Resurrection and their own resurrection. The struggle would forge a new man, re-created and renewed according to God's image and likeness in the waters of the baptismal font. Let us also use this time to renew our faith and our life in Christ. Fasting, almsgiving, the added prayers and prostrations, the increased number of church services- all of these help us to truly repent and draw closer to Our Lord Jesus Christ, Who is our life and resurrection! Let us now also pray even more fervently and with greater hope for peace in this world, especially in Ukraine, Russia, the Middle East, and the Holy Land. Therefore, "be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord." (1 Cor. 15:58)
